

FREQUENCY CURVE

A frequency curve is a smooth curve for which the total area taken is unity. It is a limiting form of histogram or frequency polygon.

Frequency curve for a distribution can be obtained by drawing a smooth & free hand curve through the midpoints of upper sides of the rectangle forming the histogram.
